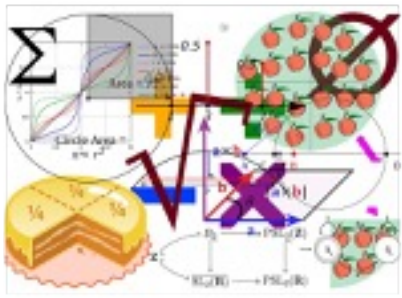


What are Learning workshops?
